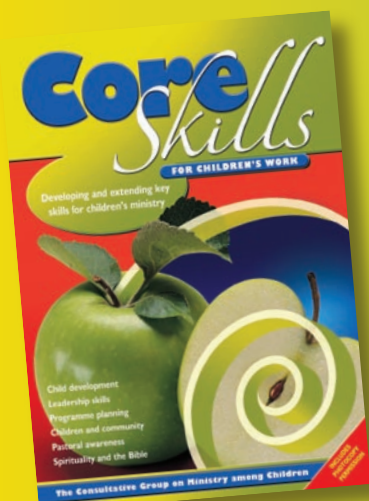


DESIGN & DELIVER
